AGED CARE - A CAREER WITH A FUTURE FOR YOU

With a fast-growing Ageing population, there is high demand and employment opportunities locally and globally for trained Aged Care workers.

The Australian Standards Aged Care Course provides you with the skills and knowledge required for Employment in Aged Care – in an Aged Care facility, community, and in-home Aged Care.

The course is perfect for people who are wanting to start a career and work as a Care Worker, as well as for those who are already working in the Aged Care industry and want to formalise recognition of their skills as their next career move.

Aged Care Skills and Knowledge Learning:

You will learn how to provide physical, social, and emotional support to the elderly, as well as how to work as part of a team with other health professionals such as nurses and healthcare workers.

- Ageing – Working as an Aged Care Worker in a residential facility, you will assist elderly people with their daily routine activities and personal care, such as showering and dressing.
 - Home and Community – Working as a Home Care Assistant, you would work to an individualised care plan that outlines activities to maintain personal care, physical and health support for clients living in their own homes. Recognise healthy body systems and support its healthy functioning
 - Provide individualised support to the elderly Follow safe work practices
 - Infection control including infection, prevention and management
 - Support the empowerment of older people and tailor their support programs
 - Support and monitor clients with dementia
 - Understand the support required by people with disabilities
- Communicate and collaborate effectively with clients, families, and co-workers. You will be taught how to use discretion and judgement in relation to providing this support and to take ownership of tasks and outcomes.

Delivery Mode

Virtual delivery by an Australian TMG Aged Care Trainer using TEAMS and TMS's Canvas Learning Management system. Training will include the use of specific Aged Care equipment. The Virtual Classroom will be delivered at the ASHA Hospital in collaboration with Eira by TMG Aged Care Trainers.

Entry Criteria:

18 Years of Age or over Completed Year 12
English – speaking, reading, and writing Computer Skills to enable you to learn virtually

Fees

The Australian Standards Aged Care Course Fee: AUD \$8,400 delivered in Hyderabad India. IELTS support is provided during the course as required.

Structure

The Australian Aged Care Course is delivered in India. Classes will be held at Hyderabad, India over a period of 6 months. Training will be delivered at ASHA Hospital (in collaboration with EIRA.) Virtually by TMG Aged Care Trainers.

Throughout your Australian Standards Aged Care Course, the focus will be on empowering you with the knowledge and competencies required by Aged Care workers to deliver individualised person-centred support to people who require assistance due to Ageing in community or residential based settings.

Pathway to Australian Accredited Qualifications

All students who successfully complete The **Australian Standards Aged Care Course** with TMG College Australia in India may have their existing skills, knowledge, and experience recognised through the application of an assessment process called Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL). The RPL process is undertaken prior to the enrolment into an Australian accredited qualification under the Australian Qualification Framework (AQF). The duration of the accredited course may be reduced to reflect the RPL granted. The RPL process costs AUS\$800

Each of the Australian Accredited Qualifications, (below) require completion of set hours of Australian Work placement in an Australian workplace. TMG College Australia will organise the work placement component of a qualification for its students.

Graduates of The Australian Standards Aged Care Course may apply for RPL if they wish to enrol in the following qualifications:
